



YES Testing Schedule 2014

All students must register in person on the day of testing; students may not pre-register online, through email, or over the phone. The first test will be taken on the same day, at a time assigned upon registration. For those who qualify, the second round of testing will take place either later in the day on the same day (after 1 PM; exact times vary) or on the day immediately following the first round. A list of round two participants will be posted at www.ac-see.org/results.htm and on the doors of the testing center a minimum of 30 minutes prior to the beginning of the second round (if held on the same day) or the evening before the second round (if held the day following the first round).

Students need to bring to the test:

- A recent 3x4 cm photo
- passport, birth certificate, or other form of identification
- a pen

To be eligible, students must:

- be enrolled in the first or second year of secondary school in Bosnia and Herzegovina or Macedonia
- be enrolled in 10th or 11th grade in Albania or Kosovo
- be enrolled in 9th or 10th grade in Bulgaria
- be a citizen of the country in which they are tested
- be a permanent resident of Kosovo in order to apply in Kosovo
- have been born between **1 January 1998 and 15 July 2000**
- students with disabilities should be born between 1 March 1997 and 15 July 2000
- have good marks in school
- contact your country office for age and grade requirements for students with special needs
